Tia Kober was an educator in the Whitehall School District for 38 years. Our elementary gymnasium is named in her honor. Ms. Kober and her family would like to support Whitehall High School graduates perusing a career in education by offering a \$500 renewable scholarship.

Scholarship Criteria:

- Students must be attending a state sponsored secondary school in Montana.
- Students must be entering into an education field of study.
- Students who continue in the education field can re-apply for this scholarship every year, up to four consecutive years.
- Completed applications are due to the Whitehall School Counselor by April 15th.
- Three staff members of Whitehall School District will individually score the applications using the same rubric. The recipient will have the highest averaged score.
- In the event that no one applies for the scholarship or no one is granted the scholarship, it can be carried over to the next year. Two scholarships could be awarded the following year, or one student could receive a double amount.
