“The Presidential Scholarship is the most prestigious scholarship at Montana State University, in recognition of academic excellence and demonstrated potential for leadership and service. Up to twenty such scholarships will be awarded to freshmen entering Montana State University each fall. The Presidential Scholarship includes a full tuition waiver and a generous stipend renewable for up to four years. Finalists who do not receive the Presidential Scholarship will be considered for the Provost Scholarship, which also provides a full tuition waiver renewable for four years and a stipend. Presidential and Provost Scholars automatically receive admission to the Honors College. A cumulative GPA of 3.75 and a composite score of 30 on the ACT or 2000 on the SAT (all 3 scores)/new SAT scores of 1410 (2 scores) are the expected norms for applicants. The Presidential Scholarship application for fall 2018 awards is 3:00pm MST, December 1, 2018. (Note: the application will be fully online.) This essay contest requires applicants (grades 9-12) to craft an original essay that “demonstrates an understanding of political courage as described by John F. Kennedy in *Profiles in Courage*.” The essay should “describe and analyze an act of political courage by a U.S. elected official who served during or after 1917, the year John F. Kennedy was born. The essay may focus on an issue at the local, state, national, or international level.” Essays should be between 700 and 1,000 words and must be submitted online or postmarked by January 4, 2019. The first place winner will earn \$10,000, second place earns \$1,000, five finalists will earn \$500, and eight will earn an award of \$100. Applicants “are encouraged to choose an original subject and tell a story that has not yet been told.” At least five sources are required as well as a bibliography listing those sources.
