PROCEDURE LEADING TO WITHDRAWAL OF TRANSPORTATION (In the case of major violations, the following steps will be followed and immediate suspension of transportation will be recommended:

 1^{st} Conduct Report: Conference with principal, parental contact, and warning of up to three (3) days suspension of transportation privileges.

 2^{nd} Conduct Report: Conference with principal, parental contact, and up to three (3) days suspension of transportation privileges.

3rd Conduct Report: Conference with principal, parental contact, and up to five (5) days suspension of transportation privileges.

4th and Subsequent Conduct Reports: Additional suspension of bus transportation up to and including withdrawal of transportation privilege.
