

# HOMECOMING 2016

**Friday:**

- Students check into 1<sup>st</sup> Period for attendance and royalty voting and Dress up Counting
- 8:20 - 9-12 students report to MP for Manly-Man Volleyball and Powder Puff (K-8 in regular classrooms – Shared staff will need to monitor/teach these classes.)
- 10:00 – K-12 Spirit Assembly (Kindergarten/Senior Walk, Presentation of the flag by Cheer Squad, Presentation of Royalty nominees, Announce winner of Elementary Spirit Posters, and Presentation of Teams)

- 10:45 – Float Decorating in the Student Parking lot – High School on the shop end, Middle School on the Elementary Playground side of parking lot.
- 12:10 Lunch
- 12:45 All students check into 6<sup>th</sup> period for attendance then stage floats for the parade.
- 1:00 Sharp – Parade led by Elementary (Mr. Head will have a schedule with the float order and Mr. Sullivan will announce the float as it passes the Star Theatre. When elementary reaches the grass area in front of Elementary wing they will line up to watch the middle school and high school floats pass. Candy will be thrown to the students at this point. The parade will turn around in the staff parking area and come back up the road to the bus alley and will then make their way across to the student parking lot and then onto the track. The floats will stay there on display for the community to check out before and during the high school Football game Friday night.

- Homecoming Royalty will be announced at the half time of the football game.
